FAQ

+ How to get here

Plan ahead and allow extra travel time when arriving for the party of to end the year of all years. Expect road closures and crowds but don't forget to stay safe & social distance. Keep up to date with transport information at www.transportnsw.info or www.sydneynewyearseve.com/public-transport/

Access our venue by bus, ferry, rail, or foot. When you arrive, expect to follow distancing regulations and get ready to say good-bye to 2020.

We strongly advise that guests do not use the parking facilities at the club, as the roads will be closed from 2:00pm on New Year's Eve and will reopen any time after 3:00am on New Year's Day.

+ Parking

Yes. For our New Year's Eve function, our car park will be available only to patrons who have purchased a ticket to the event. We strongly advise that guests do not use the parking facilities at the club, as the roads will be closed from 2:00pm on New Year's Eve and will reopen any time after 3:00am on New Year's Day.

Our daily parking cost is a flat rate of \$12 & overnight parking for \$38. Please note road closures may prevent access to Harbourview Crescent between the times of 12pm 31st December & 3am 1st January 2021. We recommend transport for easy access.

+ Public Transport

Milsons Point train station is the closest and is a short 7-minute walk via Alfred Street, then Lavender Street. We are also accessible via North Sydney Station and buses. For water services, please access via Milson Point ferry wharf or by private charter to Lavender Bay wharf.

+ Will you be open during the day of December 31st?

Yes. The Kirribilli Club will open from 10am until 2pm. All members & guests must exit the venue for an entire reset to prepare for the party of the year!

+ What time can I arrive?

Our New Years Eve celebration will start at 7pm. Arrive from as early 6:30pm to sign in & collect your wristband. Well see you there!

+ Do I need to bring anything?

You will need your ticket & photo ID to sign in upon arrival. Your entry wristband will be available for collection at registration.

+ Will I need to sign in?

Yes. Entry to the venue via front street entrance. All ticketed attendees will be required to sign in at the club registration sites and will be required to provide your full name, ticket, and contact phone number. These details will be securely stored for 28 days in the Kirribilli Club system and are used only for the purpose of tracing COVID-19 infections. This is a ticketed event and there is no public access to the venue after 2pm.

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+ Is your venue wheelchair accessible?

Yes. Accessible toilets, ramps, and spacious lifts are available throughout the entire venue. Please consider road closures when organising your trip to the Kirribilli Club. We do ask that guests using wheelchairs arrive 15 minutes earlier so we can usher you directly to your tables.

+ Is there BYO?

BYO alcohol or glassware is not permitted on-site. This is a ticketed only event where all food & beverage services are purchased directly through the Kirribilli Club.

+ Are there dress regulations?

Yes. To ensure the comfort and respect of all members and guests a dress code of smart casual attire has been put in place. We ask that hats & caps are removed upon entry to the club as a mark of respect. Singlet shirts are deemed inappropriate at any time throughout the day. T-shirts or collared shirts must be worn at all times.

+ How do I collect my wristband/ticket?

When you arrive at the venue, you will be required to sign in at the club registration sites and will be required to provide your full name, ticket, and contact phone number. At this time, you will also pick up your wristband for the event. Please note, each attendee will be required to sign in and collect their own wristband.

+ Can children come?

No. This is a strictly over-18 tickets event with no exceptions.

+ Security

The safety of our members & guests is of the highest priority. The Kirribilli Club works closely with the NSW Police Force & relevant authorities to ensure a safe & secure environment. Security will be present to ensure all attendees are applying safe COVID practises to their movement throughout the venue. The responsible service of alcohol also applies within our venue and will be enforced by our executive team & highly trained operational staff.

Security have the right to cut off any guest if they are nearing intoxication at any time throughout the night, they also have the right to escort guests out of the venue. Due to the strict COVID regulations in place this also applies to guests who do not adhere to our COVID Safety Plan. We have created a safe environment for all members and guests and this will be enforced throughout the night.
