MINORS AND CHILDREN POLICY

- We ask that parents/adult supervisors with minors/ children pay attention to signage throughout the Club, regarding restricted areas for minors/ children under 18.
- (Minors under 18) Children must be accompanied and always supervised by a responsible adult.
- A "Responsible Adult" is a person/adult supervisor over the age of 18 years and includes:
 - A parent, stepparent, or guardian of the minor.
 - The minor's spouse or de facto partner.
 - A person standing in as the parent of the minor i.e., a grandparent, aunt/ uncle, or person in charge of an organised sporting or school group.
- Minors/ children are not permitted to be in Restricted Areas of the Kirribilli Ex Services Club at any time, in accordance with legislation and licensing restrictions.
- Restricted Areas include Sports Bar, TAB area, and all Gaming Floor areas (smoking/ non-smoking).
- Minors/ children are strictly prohibited from being sold, supplied or consuming alcohol in any form whilst on Club premises. Any minor/ child found to be in the possession of, or attempting to purchase alcohol, will be removed from Club premises.
- Minors/ children are only permitted to stay on the premises until 22:00, unless attending a function.
- Minors/ children must always have footwear on.
- Bringing your own food onto Club premises is prohibited, with baby food being an exception.
- Members and guests are advised that leaving children unattended in any part of Club premises (or in vehicles) is unacceptable conduct and may result in members/ guests being asked to leave the Club. Such breaches may also be subject to disciplinary action against the member/ guests.
- The accompanying Responsible Adult is to ensure that their minor/ child behaves in an appropriate manner when on Club premises and refrains from behaviour which is likely to cause discomfort or inconvenience to other members/ guests. Such behaviour includes, but is not limited to, screaming, running around unsupervised between tables, behaving in a loud and unruly manner, swearing, intimidating, and pushing or play- fighting with other minors/ children.
- Unacceptable behaviour of a Minor/ child may result in the Minor/ child and their accompanying Responsible Adult being asked to leave the Club premises.
